### NOTE:


The receiver drier need only be changed under the following circumstances: There is dirt in the refrigerant circuit (eg. compressor seizure). The system is leaking and refrigerant has been lost to atmosphere. Refrigerant circuit has been open more than 24 hours due to repair.


# NOTE:





  - Install the 4 bolts and tighten to 10 Nm (7 lb.ft).
