## Removal


1. Disconnect the battery ground cable. For additional information, refer to <u>Specifications</u> (Section 414-00 Charging System - General Information)

- 2. Remove the floor console. For additional information, refer to Floor Console (76.25.01) (Section 501-12 Instrument Panel and Console)

CAUTION: Make sure the wiring harness is protected when cutting the carpet.

Remove the yaw rate sensor.

- Cut the carpet for access.
- Position the wiring harness aside.
- Disconnect the electrical connector.
- Remove the two retaining bolts.



## Installation

- 1. Install the yaw rate sensor.
  - Tighten the bolts to 7 Nm (5 lb.ft).

  - Attach the wiring harness.
  - Attach the carpet.
