Appendix B – DVB-T function operating manual

Remote control battery installation

Before attempting to operate your remote control, install the battery as described below.

- 1. Turn the remote control face down.
- 2. Press down on the ridged area of the battery cover and slide it off.
- 3. Slide battery in obeying the polarity.
